New M&P WG focus areas



- Global Sulphur Cap 2020: must be communicated in an objective way by ECG to the industry and market to prepare them for this game changer (cf. articles in weekly ECG News and...)
- Exchange best practices on **environmentally friendly investments** by ECG members, incl. how can they obtain benefits and cost reductions from the public sector (EU, States, Port Authorities, etc.)











New M&P WG focus areas

- Share information/achievements among members to ensure that more ECG members are obtaining EU funding – e.g. CEF & Horizon 2020
- Further standardization; Fast Track in the port terminals – co-ordination with other ECG WGs (Operations, Digitalisation)
- Challenge the OEMs to become more active and challenge the ECG members to address demands/issues towards the OEMs
- Be the voice and force of the ECG members towards the public and the market










0.5% Global Sulphur Cap in 2020 – Updated ECG Briefing Report
